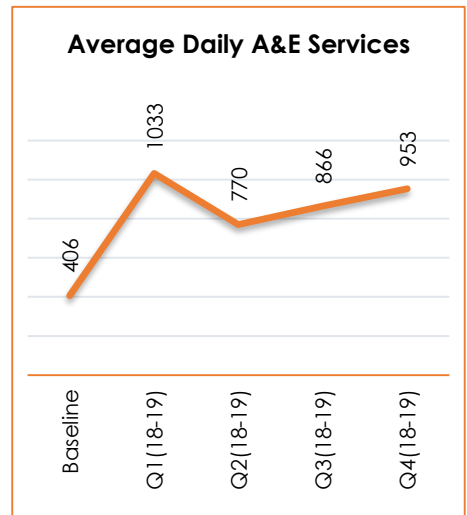
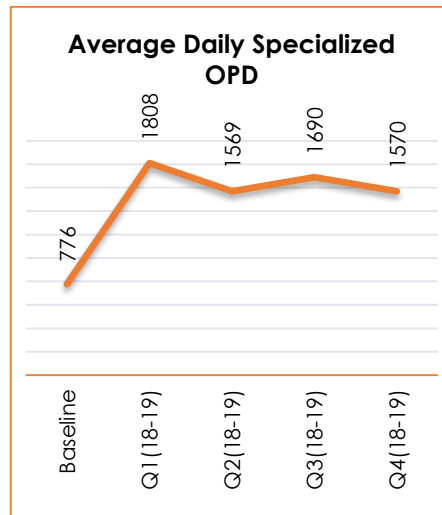
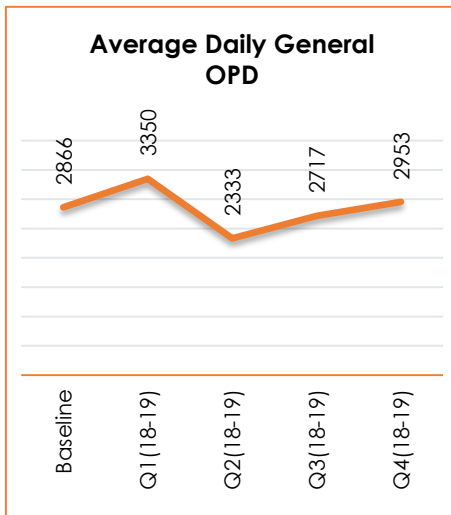
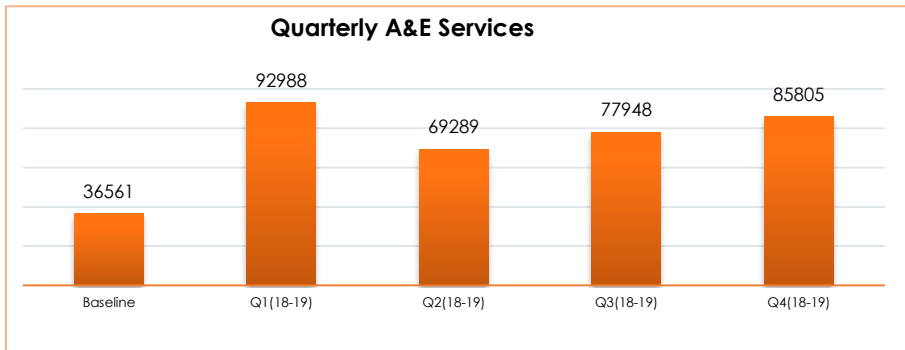
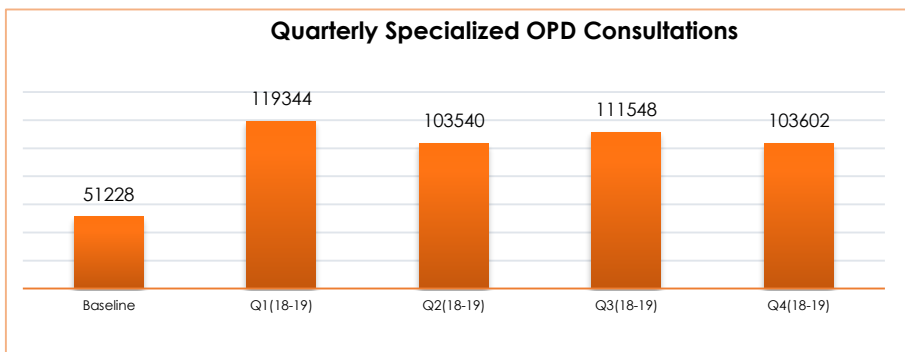
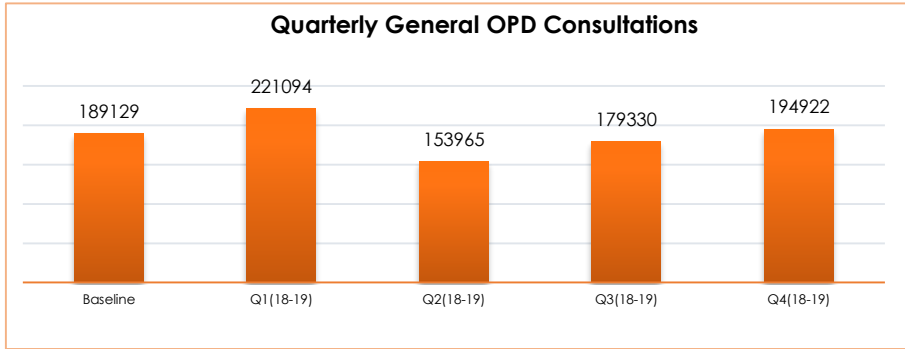
## Our Objective

- To develop and advocate policies for health systems strengthening.

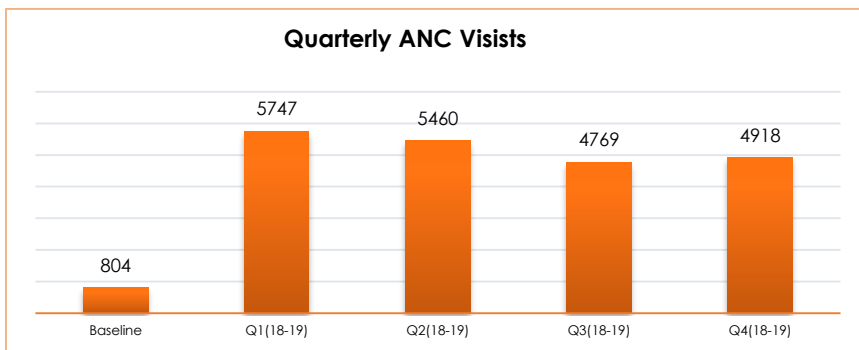
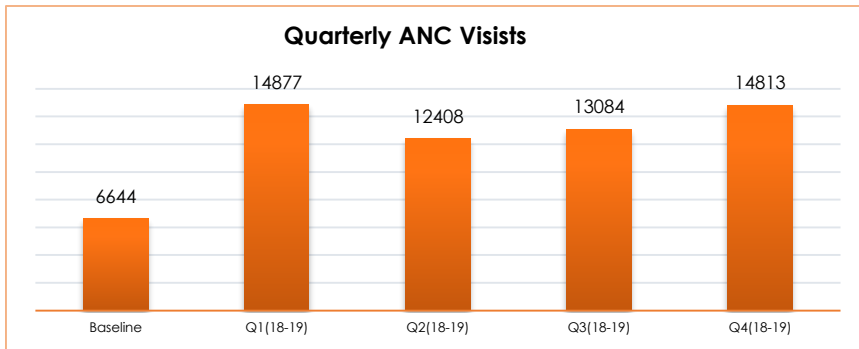
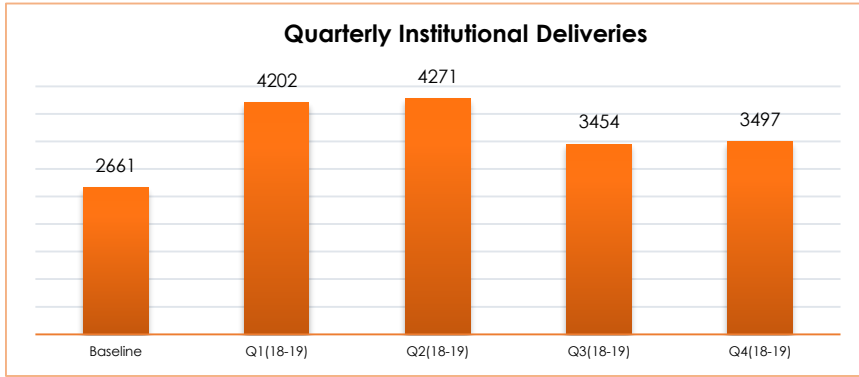

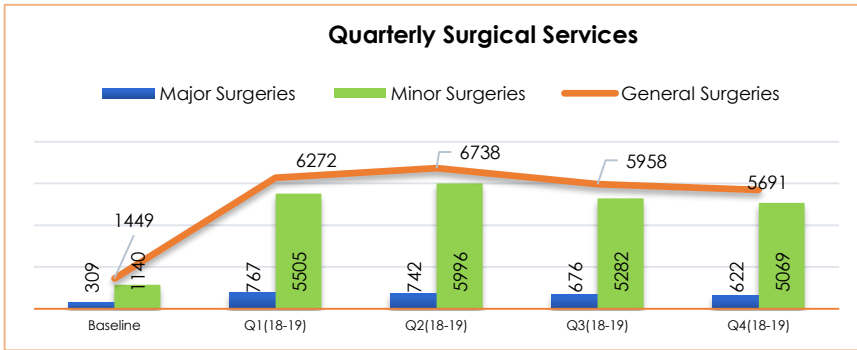

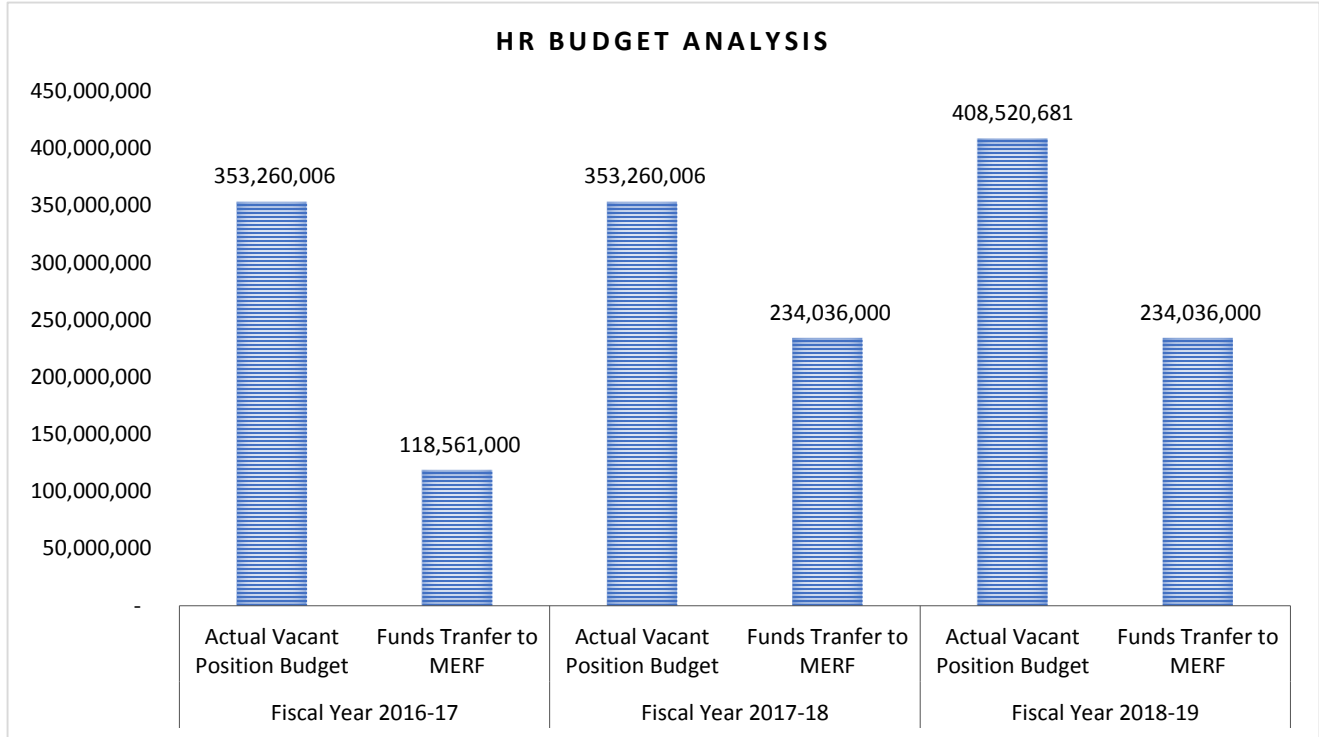
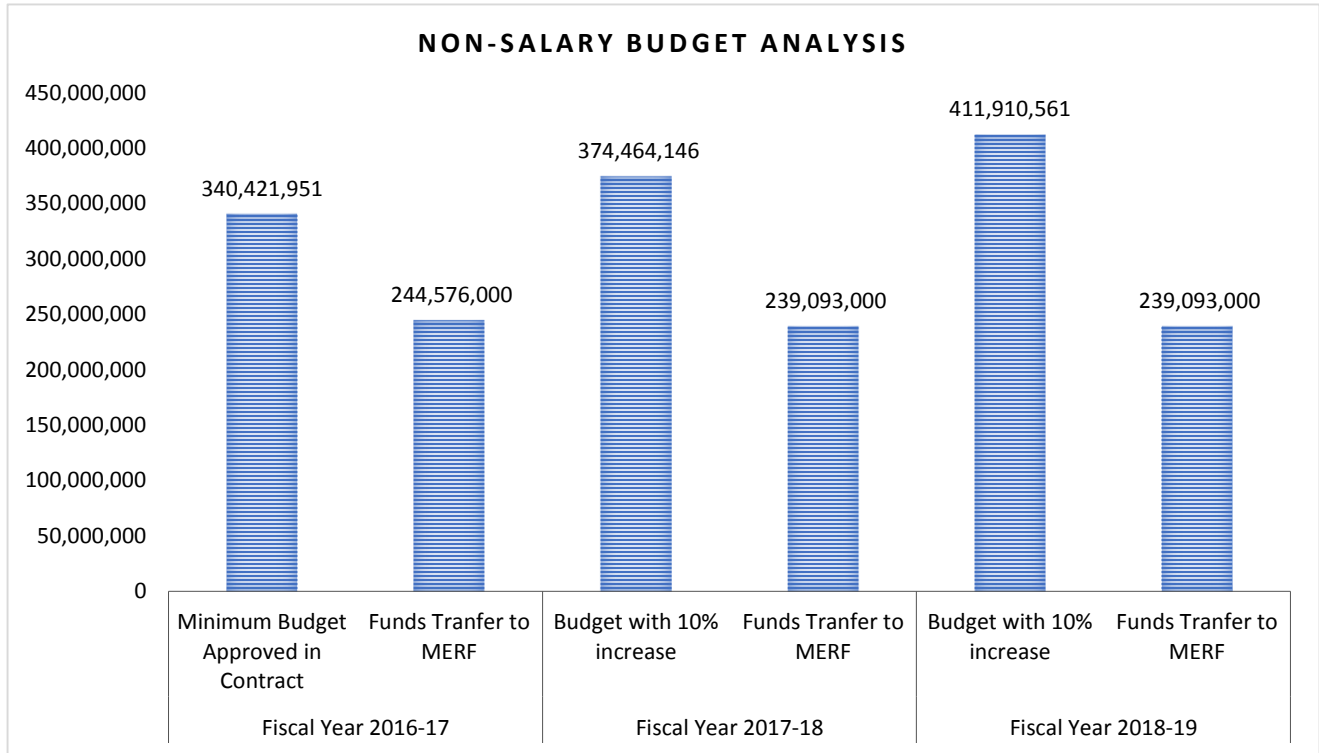


## Logistic Management Information System (LMIS)

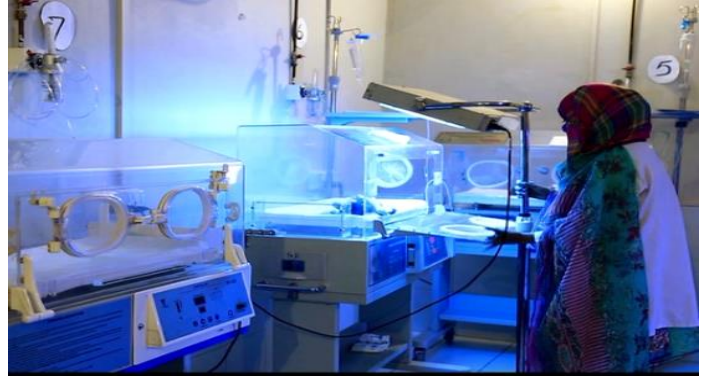

## Challenges

### Budgetary allocation viz-a-viz service delivery expectations

Expectation of key stake holders, particularly higher authorities, political leadership and media persons during their visits of the hospitals to provide free of cost health services. These expectations include even tertiary level services and OPD medicines round the clock. However, there is too much gap between budgetary allocations and caseload that is increasing day by day. Following is summary on budget required and actual disbursement;

### Regularity & Capacity of available HR

Regularity and existing capacity of medics and paramedics remained key issue for general public at starting time of Public Private Partnership. Under PPP initiative regularity and punctuality of the staff has improved significantly. The training of doctors and paramedics for different departments especially in ER and MNCH is organized by MERF itself or managed through Health Department, AKU and other Non-government initiatives. MERF has plan for the consequent year i.e. 2019 – 20 on capacity building.

### Involvement of key technical staff in Polio Eradication Campaign

Involvement of key technical staff in polio vaccination campaigns almost 15 – 20 days for preparation, polio campaign and post campaign review. Generally Medical Officers and other staff from local hospitals are engaged in polio campaign. However, in some cases instead of local Government Dispensary or BHU; Medical staff from RHCs, THQs or DHQs under MERF management is assigned the duty for Polio Eradication Campaign.

### Transfers & Postings

Transfer & Postings of the medics and paramedics without consultation with Partner (MERF) as provided in the contract. This is always challenging for Hospital administration or even MERF to maintain the services. It also includes the permission to doctors for different trainings, approval of long leaves, deputation and assignment of different duties.

An important factor that aggravates the deficiency of human resource in public sector healthcare facilities of Thatta and Sujawal districts is deputation of medical doctors. This means that the healthcare staff that is hired on positions at these healthcare facilities is not providing services elsewhere while still drawing salaries from the same budget. Healthcare facilities of both districts face a similar issue. Following tables shows details of Medical Officers hired at various healthcare facilities that is either relieved for post graduate study or on deputation.
